 - Transferred credit from another accredited secondary school outside Jordan School District.
 - Make-up credits or credit taken at an accredited, educational institution to make-up for failed courses.
 - JSD Summer School information is available through Valley High School; phone 572-7035.
 - Electronic High School <http://ehs.uen.org>. (Required completion within 12 months)
 - Enrichment/accelerated credit to supplement regular coursework or to accelerate toward early graduation.
 - District approved tests, portfolios, or other performance appraisals such as the High School Entry Level Placement (HELP) Tests.
